Year 5 Prehistory Day School Trip

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Thursday 28th November, Year 5 will be going on a school trip to Celtic Harmony Camp in Brickendon, Hertfordshire. This trip will focus on further educating the children about the day to day life during the Stone, Bronze and Iron Age. Pupils will have opportunities for hands-on experiences using tools and materials from these time periods, such as:

- Grinding grain to bake bread
- Weaving on weighted looms
- Dying materials with herbs
- Trading

We will be leaving school at 8.45am, so could we please ask that your child arrives at school by 8.20am so they can be registered and on the coach in plenty of time. We intend to return to school by 3:45pm, but if for any reason the coach is delayed a text will be sent out to you. The cost of this trip is £24.75. Payment and parent consent for this trip needs to be made through parent pay. Payment can be made in 2 instalments of £12.37 and £12.38 no later than Monday 25th November. There is also an opportunity for the children to purchase items through a trading activity. Therefore, on the day they can bring between £2 - £5 spending money, which they will need to take responsibility for, although this is optional.

During the day, the children will be spending the majority of the time outside completing these activities, so warm clothes, hats, gloves and a scarf as well as suitable warm foot wear will be needed. Closer to the date of the trip, we will be sending out a letter to give you more information about suitable clothing for the trip. Also, children will need to bring a packed lunch with them. If they are entitled to a Free School Meal a school packed lunch will be provided for your child. (Please advise the school office if this is not required.)
