

FUN WAYS TO LEARN YOUR SPELLINGS

SPEEDY SPELLING: How many times can you write the word correctly in 1 minute?

MESSY SPELLING: Put some shaving foam, or flour, or sugar, or sand on a table and using your finger, write your spellings in them.

RAINBOW SPELLINGS: Write out each word in your spellings 7 times—each one in a different colour of the rainbow.

WET SPELLING: Get an old washing-up liquid water bottle and fill with water. Spell your spellings by squirting the water bottle onto a pavement or patio.

SPELLING BEE: Get an adult to test you on your spellings (after you've practised them of course!) and spelling it out loud to them.

ACTIVE SPELLING: Create actions to help you remember the order of letters in your spellings. Create a spelling dance or spelling exercise routine even!

SPOT THE SPELLING: Get someone in your house to write down your spelling twice, once correctly and once incorrectly e.g. was and woz. Can you spot the correct one?

READ, COVER, WRITE, CHECK: Read the word, cover it up, write it down, check it!

BUILD A WORD: If you have the game Scrabble or letter fridge magnets, use them to build your spellings. Not got these? Write letters on different pieces of paper and make your own!

TEXT YOUR SPELLINGS: Text someone in your family your spellings.

PLAY HANGMAN: Play the game hangman with someone in your family and use your spellings as the words to guess.

SENTENCE SPELLINGS: Put each spelling into a sentence. Can you put all your spellings in one paragraph or long sentence?!!

ANAGRAMS: Ask someone to write the letters of your spelling in a different order. Can you re-arrange them to spell the word correctly?
