Jewellery in PE

It is the policy of the school and of the Local Authority that no jewellery is to be worn for any physical activity. Taping earrings for any reason is not allowed. This means that if pupils cannot take their earrings out they will have to sit out of PE until they can remove their earrings or a parent or carer would need to visit the school to assist.

If you intend to have your child's ears pierced it would be better to do so at the start of the summer holidays to allow time to heal. This would mean that they would be able to remove jewellery themselves at the beginning of their new school year. ***It is advisable that pupils do not wear earrings at all on PE days.***

PE Kit

Please ensure that all PE kit (as well as uniform) is named. Writing on the label with permanent ink is a successful method. Pupils must have kit in school at all times, it will be sent home periodically for laundering. Children attending after school clubs should bring in a separate change of clothes or must change at the end of the session, leaving their PE kit in school. Some spare kit is kept in classes but this is a limited resource for unexpected circumstances.

Years 5 and 6

In September we are phasing in a new sky blue PE T-Shirt. Children in Years 5 or 6 with the blue top can opt to wear their kit to school on the day/s they have PE. We will be moving to blue tops only from September 2022.

Hairstyles and Accessories

The school is proud of its smart uniform and the image of the school that this presents, both in school and beyond the school community. The school's expectations for hair styles are equally high as they contribute to this positive image.

- All long hair must be tied back with suitable elastics, hair ties, hair clips or bands. Hair accessories should be in keeping with school uniform colours and not too large.



- Coloured hair is not acceptable in school. This includes dying, bleaching, highlights or lowlights and coloured hair extensions.
- Pupils must not have braids or plaits that end in beads, patterns shaved into the hair or any extreme hairstyles such as severe Mohicans.



Footwear

All school footwear must be plain black or dark brown sensible school shoes. ***White or coloured piping, soles, laces, logo or decoration is not permitted.***

If parents prefer, Eversley pupils may change into plain black plimsolls on arrival in school. They can change back into their shoes at break and lunchtime.

Footwear during the school day is as important as the rest of our school uniform. All pupils must have plimsolls/trainers (with their name in) in school as part of their PE kit and we are happy for them to change into these during the school day if they are not wearing plain black school shoes.

Unfortunately, spare plimsolls are not readily available in school.
