Mental Health Support for Young People and Teenagers

Kooth is a mental health and wellbeing platform that offers online text based counselling support for 11-18 year olds. Not only do they offer access to counselling, they also feature self help tools including online journaling, goal setting and mindfulness techniques. There is also a community space on their Kooth magazine and discussion boards where young people can give and receive advice and support from others their age.

Kooth is staffed by fully trained and qualified counsellors who are available until 10pm each night, 365 days per year. With no long waiting times or referral process, Kooth is a fantastic way for young people to get the help and support they need, when they need it, rather than having to wait long periods for an appointment.
