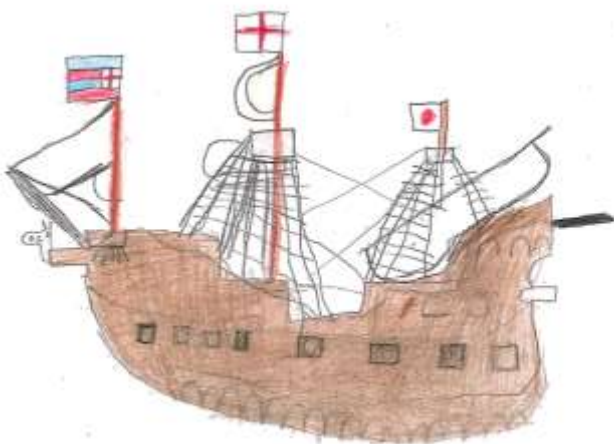
Dear Parents / Carers
