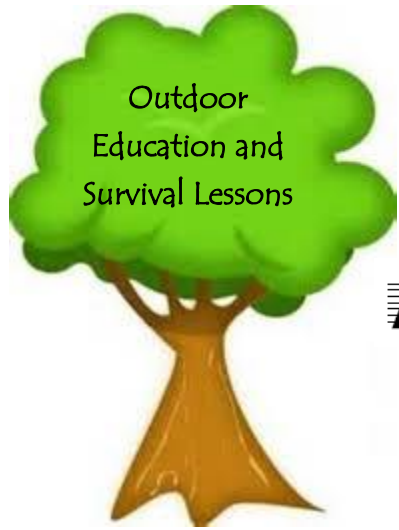


Equipping Eversley Children for Life




The Eversley Curriculum
