If your income is less than £16,190 per year, or you receive income support or an equivalent benefit, you may be entitled to free school meals for your child. For further information and to make an application visit:

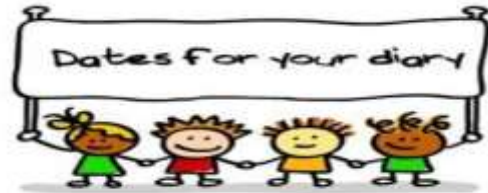
